GUIDELINES / INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES:

Please read the following guidelines carefully before filling in the application form.

- 1) Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected.**
- 2) Selection based on false information will be ipso facto rejected.**

ELIGIBILITY:

A candidate shall be eligible to apply for admission to Diploma Programs provided:-

- (a) He / She has passed the HSLC / 10 + 2 or equivalent examination from any Board / University recognized by the Government of India in all the subjects and has obtained 40% marks minimum in case of ST/ SC and 50% marks minimum in case of others.
- (b) Candidates who have appeared and are awaiting HSLC/ 10+2/ equivalent Examination results are eligible. However, they shall be required to fulfill the above mentioned condition on declaration of the HSLC/10+2 or equivalent result.
- (c) He/ She is within the age group of 15 to 21 years (For Pharmacy - 23 years) on the 1st March of 2019.
- (d) He/ She is mentally sound to undergo the course of study.
- (e) He/ She bears a good moral character.

All intending candidates shall:

- (a) Submit an application duly filled in the prescribed form within the time specified.
- (b) Fill the application with name as per HSLC/ Matric Admit Card in Capital Letters (sufficient gap should be kept between the first name, second name, third name and so on).
- (c) Attach self attested copies of the following documents along with the application.
 - (a) HSLC Examination Admit Card.
 - (b) HSLC Marksheet.
 - (c) 10+2 Admit Card (If applicable)
 - (d) 10+2 or equivalent examination Mark sheet (If applicable)
- (d) Furnish:- Whichever is applicable.
 - (a) Scheduled Tribe Certificate, Indigenous Inhabitant Certificate and Backward Tribe Certificate.
 - (b) Non- Naga Local Indigenous Inhabitant Certificate.
 - (c) Certificate of Employment from the Head of the Department.
 - (d) Certificate from head of the Department specifying the year and the date of either of the parents joining service in Nagaland.

General Information :

- (i) Over writing should be avoided.
- (ii) The Directorate shall not be responsible for any loss in transit of any material sent by post.
- (iii) For any additional information required, the Directorate of Technical Education, Nagaland may be contacted.
- (iv) The allotment of place to the selected candidate for Diploma Program will be done by this Office, basing on the eligibility criteria for admission as laid down by the concerned Institute.
